Help and encourage pastors and churches involved in cross-cultural ministries.

Goals

- Increase the numbers of African Americans being trained at theologically reformed seminaries.
- Create Internships/Apprenticeships at PCA and reformed churches.
- Find ministry opportunities in PCA churches for African American leaders and seminary graduates.
- Plant PCA churches and develop ministries that share in the vision.
- Start college campus ministries with a special focus on historically black colleges and universities.
- Help PCA churches interested in becoming more accessible to other cultures and ethnic groups.
- Help raise funds for leadership development and church planting.
