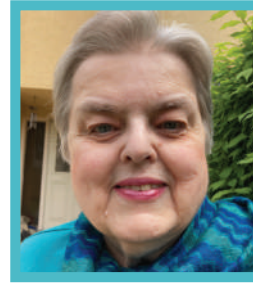

Mission to North America

Why is MNA Refugee and Immigrant Ministry needed?

- 1 in 4 in North America is either foreign-born or a child of a foreign-born parent.
- The Lord has brought the nations to our neighborhoods for His Sovereign purposes. (Acts 17:26, 27)
- Healthy, sustainable churches are alert to what God is doing and embrace it.
- We can help churches navigate next steps unique to circumstances and opportunities.

How can local ministry to Refugees or Immigrants impact your Church?

- Excitement of sharing the Good News with some who have truly never heard it!
- Fresh spiritual insights and talents of diverse new believers
- Increased credibility as American nonbelievers observe Christ's power to unify hearts across cultures – John 17:19-21
- Immigrants who don't yet know Him are more open to the Gospel than those in their homelands – and often more open than unchurched Americans!



Even a single authentic cross-cultural friendship has great Kingdom potential!



What options are there for our Church to get involved?

- Welcome a refugee family.
- Start an English as a Second Language (ESL) ministry.

- Develop outreach to international students.
- Cultivate ministry to immigrant children in their neighborhood.
- Partner with a local immigrant congregation.
- Partner with immigrant believers to offer a Bible study in another language.
- Global missions/local match
- Befriend immigrant neighbors; welcome them in meaningful ways.
- And so much more...
